natural harbour's strategic geographical location makes it an important transshipment gateway for the

American, European and Asian shipping routes.

Port of Taichung

The Port of Taichung, located on the west coast of central Taiwan surpassed Keelung port in 2010 to become

the second-largest port in Taiwan after Kaohsiung port. It focuses on regional container traffic.

Port of Hualien

The Port of Hualien, facing the Pacific Ocean in the east of Taiwan is an artificial harbour that mainly transports

local gravel, cement, and marble. The port also serves the tourism and leisure industry for cruises and whale-

watching boats.

Shanghai Free Trade Zone Approved

Shanghai has won approval from China's State Council to set up a pilot free trade zone, according to a Ministry of Commerce statement.

A general plan governing the operation of the free trade zone, which spans 28.78 square kilometers in Waigaoqiao Free Trade Zone, Waigaoiao Free Trade Logistics Park, Yangshan Free Trade Port Area and Pudong Airport Comprehensive Free Trade Zone in Shanghai, has yet to be released.

"When completed, the free zone will provide world-class transport and communications facilities and tax-free environment for domestic and foreign enterprises as a major hub of their supply chains in Asia," said state-owned China Daily.

The pilot zone is a crucial move in adapting to global economic and trade development, the ministry said, adding that the pilot will help China explore a new path for opening to international trade, speed up transformation of government functions and promote economic restructuring.

Carriers return to core services, relinquish more novel transport roles

Hard times in business are inducing carriers to return to core services, relinquishing logistics and other peripheral offerings as demonstrated by Maersk's sale of its US trucking unit, Bridge Terminal Transport.

Carriers appear to recognise that one-stop shops are not the way forward and notions of vertical integration should be replaced by a focus on core services, according to Drewry Maritime Research.

In June, Maersk sold its European ERS Railways to Freightliner. In May, Zim sold its holdings in container manufacturing plants. In April, MSC sold 35 per cent of its ports division Terminal Investments and in January, CMA CGM sold its 49 per cent stake in port operator Terminal Link to China Merchants.

Dreams of carriers offering door-to-door integrated logistics services are unlikely to be resurrected soon. This will cheer forwarders and 3PL who have long said carriers should stay clear of logistics, said the Drewry report.

With too many vessels chasing too little cargo, carriers have returned to a port-to-port focus suitable to commodity pricing, making it easier for independent forwarding agents to provide more customer focused supply chain management solutions.
